# Hospital FCN programs

#### **Providing Services**

- Volunteer nurses supporting their communities

# New models/ideas interested in:

- Congregational Volunteer Model Extending the program to other denominations other than Catholic partners
- Connecting Catholics with hospital spiritual care departments- training Ministers to the Sick to volunteer with local hospital.
- We had a small **FCN group of nurses** from various faith communities that **met bi-monthly at the hospital**. That stopped during COVID. Would like to see that started back up.
- We would love to see faith community nurse ministries expand across health systems.
  - We created a recent Playbook for FCN Ministry to give hospitals/health systems the tools they need to start a FCN or Faith and Health Partnership program & seek to partner with our Community Health and Population Health colleagues to train our interested FCNs/HMs (and possibly CHWs) to lead/facilitate chronic disease management programs & provide advance care planning educational tools.
- Reimbursement for nurses from CMS.
- Hire and embed faith community nurses (as employees) to directly partner with and support local faith communities
  and/or other community based-organizations in need, particularly those that are traditionally underserved, marginalized
  and vulnerable.



# Suggestions for CHA:

- Continue the networking calls and to offer national meetings.
- Advocacy for all Catholic healthcare systems to create health ministry/faith-health partnership programs in all regions/markets.
  - partner with USCCB to highlight FCN- share what FCN is all about and encourage parishes to embrace and partner with FCN.
  - raise awareness about the wonderful FCN programs in many Catholic health systems that are improving the whole-person health of those they serve.
- Care Coordination Resources
  - Coping with difficult situations where families are tapped out of funds for family members who are mentally ill, disabled or elderly. volunteers do not always stay & its confusing trying to get people connected with resources.
     There is a need for volunteers to help people navigate government funds, Medicare and Medicaid resources.
  - How to coordinate follow-up care post-hospital, long-term mental health care, communication with discharge planners and ER staff with community resources. Respite care for People experiencing homelessness. Helping care providers understand digital access is a social determinant of health and a barrier to care.
